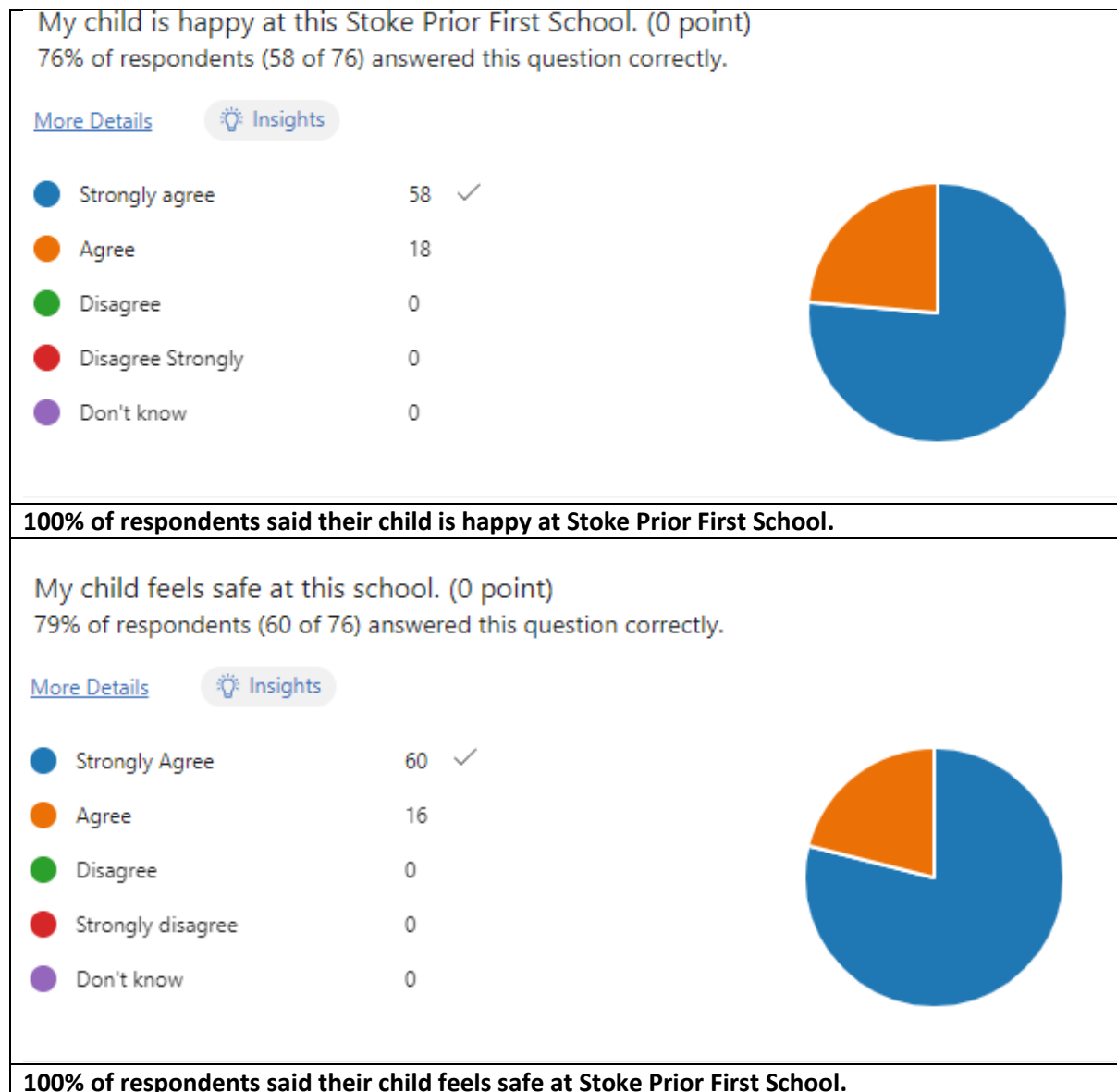


Results from the 2023 Annual Parental Survey

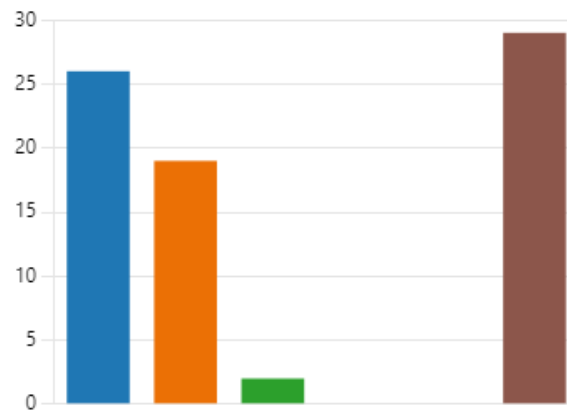

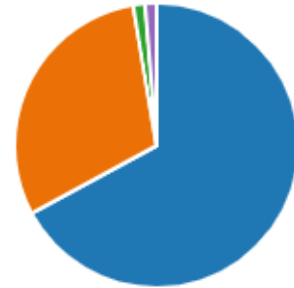

I would imagine there are software platforms that would allow teachers and parents to communicate more clearly, while also providing updates on the child's activities. This was certainly the case when my child was at nursery.</p>	<p><i>Reporting on a child's activities during the day is challenging because of teacher workload. We publish termly curriculum overviews, and update the website regularly with what the children are doing in school in order for parents and carers to get a sense of what is happening in school.</i></p>

The change was communicated and assumed that there had been a wider consultation with parents on this topic, which we fell has not been the case.</p>	<p><i>We know changes to the school day would cause concerns for some families. We consulted parents and staff and made a decision based on the results.</i></p>
<p>More time spent in forest school and PE ideally but realise limitations of school day and curriculum requirement.</p>

<p>The only issue I have had this academic year is the lack of PE I'm Yr R as my child has come home most weeks saying they have not completed PE sessions at all since Easter. However other than this I am extremely happy with the school and the teachers have always made my child's experience I really positive one.</p>	<p><i>During the year, we trialled a different delivery approach for PE in Reception. As a result, the children didn't have a 'traditional' PE lesson. The change was very positive in terms of overall curriculum time and the children still met all the learning goals for physical development. We do however accept that this change should have been communicated more clearly to parents and carers.</i></p>
<p>It would be great if there were better parking provisions for the school. The school does update with children's learning however to better align with any learning support from home including visits to museums etc. it would be great if we could have more regular updates of topic areas for the term in advance.</p>	<p><i>All school face issues regarding parking. Forest School is an excellent opportunity for this to happen and we will look to increase this again next year.</i></p>

It also allows pupils to upload achievements from outside of school to share with their class friends.</p>	<p><i>We fully appreciate the need for easy communication and work hard to ensure it is simple and straightforward. We don't currently have any plans for a specific communication platform as for the vast majority of parents and carers, email an phone during the day works well.</i></p>
