The Platinum Award is the highest award on offer, as a school is required to be at the Gold level for three consecutive years. The School Games Mark is a Government-led award scheme launched in 2012, facilitated by the Youth Sport Trust to reward schools for their commitment to the development of competition across their school and into the community, and we are delighted to have been recognised for our success. Last year, we had our highest ever total of children competing in local inter-school competitions, and we are extremely proud of our pupils for their dedication to all aspects of school sport, including those young volunteers, leaders and officials who made our competitions possible.





As part of our application, we were asked to fulfil criteria in the areas of participation, competition, workforce and clubs, and we are pleased that the hard work of everyone at our school has been rewarded this year. ### First Aid update

As part of our ongoing commitment to keeping children safe in school, we have reviewed our head bump procedure.

Should a child have a head bump during the day, they will be treated by a first aider and appropriate treatment will be provided. A text message and yellow letter will be sent to parents and carers but in addition, a special wristband will now be given to your child with the date and time that the head bump happened. This will then ensure any staff working with your child throughout the remainder of the day have a visual reminder that a head bump has occurred and they will monitor your child for any further symptoms. Furthermore, the person collecting your child at the end of the day will also know about the head bump.
