





Results from the 2025 Annual Parental Survey



5. The school makes me aware of what my child will learn during the year.



6. When I have raised concerns with the school they have been dealt with properly.



7. The school has high expectations for my child.



8. My child does well at this school.



9. The school lets me know how my child is doing



10. There is a good range of subjects available to my child at this school.



11. My child can take part in clubs and activities at this school.



12. The school supports my child's wider personal development.



Comments about the school (anonymised if required)	Senior Leader Response
It was would be great if there could be more choice of aftercare activities. This year it has been really limited for the reception aged children compared to older children. Are the school still exploring timed slots for wraparound?	<p><i>We are always looking at and updating our club offer. We try to accommodate all children's interests and this includes reception children, however this is not always possible due to their age. In the past, some Reception clubs have not been able to go ahead due to limited uptake.</i></p> <p><i>If there is a club idea your child would be keen on, please do let us know and we will see if we are able to organise it.</i></p> <p><i>A consultation around wrap around was sent out in September, and it was decided to keep the structure as it is for now.</i></p>
A more broader selection of after school clubs such as coding, BSL or other sporting activities so that the children can be challenged and learn a new skill. I believe setting some homework would help us parents to help better support our children around current topics being taught during a term or around where the child or class require extra support.	<p><i>We will certainly see if we are able to offer coding/BSL as a club next year. If your child has anything they are interested in please do let us know and we will always see what we can do.</i></p> <p><i>Our homework policy can be found on the website and outlines what we believe should be asked of children at this age outside of school. It also states that if you wish for more, please do speak to your child's teacher. There are</i></p>

	<i>also suggestions on the class pages for websites you can access at home.</i>
I think maybe children going to school on PE days, this works well where I work. Would avoid children wearing weeks old PE kit which is kept at school, but also provide some privacy particularly for the older girls and boys and in years 3 and 4.	<i>This is how we used to run PE days, however we made the decision last year to bring kit into school for a rang of reasons, including teaching children life skills such as dressing/undressing, organisation of own items; safeguarding; we are then able to do PE lessons or be physically active at unplanned times, whereas when it is set to specific days this isn't possible; children always have a change of clothes in school should they require it.</i>
