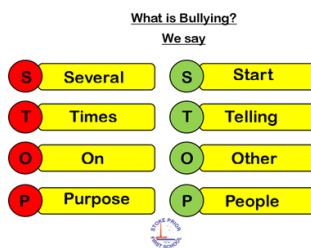

Anti-Bullying Week

In school we work really hard to teach the children about anti-bullying as part of our PSHE curriculum, assembly programme and day to day ethos. This week is Anti-Bullying Week, coordinated in England, Wales and Northern Ireland by the Anti-Bullying Alliance. This year's theme is '[Make A Noise About Bullying](#)', with the aim of empowering children to do something positive to counter the harm and hurt that bullying causes. This week in school, the children have spent time listening and discussing the themes around bullying and, most importantly, revisiting our very clear and effective message on the subject. A number of years ago, we introduced a very clear way to help children remember how to identify if they might be being bullied as well as what to do next. This very much fits with this year's theme.
