## We did...

Below we have outlined the ways in which we currently invite you in to school, which we will continue to do, along with some new ideas and ways we'd like to get you involved moving forward.

- Reception induction stay and play sessions take place in July. These are two afternoon sessions where we invite you to come and spend time in your child's new classroom, before they start in September
- Meet the teacher takes place in September, where you can come in and meet your child's new teacher, in their new classroom, for all year groups
- Reception family fun afternoons take place across the year
- Reception phonics information evening is held in September
- Year One phonics information evening is held in September
- Family assemblies for all year groups take place across the year
- Harvest, Christmas and Easter service (at the church), where you are all invited to walk with us and join us for the service
- Sports day - a fun day for all the family

Some of our new ideas are:

- Arts week - this year families have been invited in to an art workshop each day! We hope you have enjoyed these sessions
- Open classrooms - this will take place in July and is an opportunity for you to visit your child's classroom, see their work from the whole year and then visit the class and teacher they will be joining in September
- In October, after half term, Mrs Bullock will be running some phonics drop ins for Year One parents. You will be able to sign up to a session where you will take part in a phonics lesson with your child so you can see how they work
- Each class, from September, will have 6 weeks of Forest School timetabled across the year. In the 6<sup>th</sup> and final session, we would like to invite family members in to share the fun!
- We would also like to hold Christmas and Easter parent workshops, similar to the arts week sessions, where you have the opportunity to come in and engage in an activity with your child
